"LORD, HELP ME."

THREE TO GET READY: The following questions are based on the Scripture Readings for next weekend's Liturgy. I encourage you, as you prepare to celebrate Mass with us, to make the time to read these passages, and to reflect on the questions. **1. (Isaiah 22:19-23)** *Shebna, the man in charge of King Hezekiah's palace is losing his job because he overstepped his authority, and took his position for granted. Eliakim is chosen by God to replace Shebna because he is a faithful servant of God. What would happen to a faithful servant of God in our government leadership today?* **2. (Romans 11: 33-36)** *The depth of the riches, the wisdom and the knowledge of God are ours in Christ Jesus. Imagine that!* **3. (Matthew (16:13-20)** *Who do you say that Jesus is? What difference does your relationship with Jesus make in your life?*





LITURGICAL REFLECTION – The acclamation of praise accompanying the reception of the Consent is followed by the Blessing and Giving of Rings. The priest or deacon blesses the rings (three options), sprinkling them with baptismal water, and gives them to the bride and bridegroom. The husband then places his wife's ring on her finger, praying the designated prayer. Likewise, the wife places her husband's ring on the ring finger while saying the prayer. These prayers should be audible to all in the assembly gathered for the Sacrament of Matrimony.
